Mount Morgan Central State School will receive

\$146,947*

This funding will be used to:

- Directly target the delivery of the Reading Inquiring Cycle 2019.
- Improve implementation of and communication around Individual Curriculum Plans (ICP) across the school.
- Track student attendance data and absence reasons.

Our initiatives include:

- Fortnightly opportunities to moderate student progress data, discuss and plan for student next step learning.
- Intensive professional development opportunities for teachers to collaborate with speech pathologist, Head of Curriculum (HOC) and professional learning community members one day per term to refine understanding of the reading action plan.
- Building capacity of staff to consistently identify students requiring ICP support, through regular communication in Social Justice Committee (SJC) and student support meetings.
- Teachers working closely with HOC, Support Teacher – Diverse Learners (ST-DL), Guidance Officer and HOSES to implement ICP and student support.
- Employing an Administrative Officer (AO2) to initiate, collect and follow up on student absences.

Our school will improve student outcomes by:
